UNIFORM CONTRACT

As a member of the Forest Park High School Band Program, you are given privileges as well as responsibilities. One of these privileges is to represent your school with the highest honor and pride. With this commitment comes the responsibility for your behavior ON AND OFF the field. This includes classes, bus trips, football games and competitions; before, during and after each event.

A key part of your responsibility is accountability to the Band and the Band Boosters for the careful handling of your band uniform and all of it's elements. This is an expensive piece of equipment assigned to you for your use during the season. This uniform must be treated carefully, just as you care for your instrument. Failure to care for your uniform in the manner described to you in this contract may result in monetary fines to you for the repairs or replacement should loss or damage be beyond reasonable wear.

FOREST PARK HIGH SCHOOL UNIFORM CONTRACT AND RULES

- Uniform must be requested by assigned number – see posted uniform list
- Band t-shirt and white shorts **MUST** be worn under the uniform – no colors or logo
- Long white socks must be worn – no ankle, golf, tennis or other short socks; no colors (such as on the heel) or logos
- Shoes should be cleaned at home, before each event
- Scrubs are to be worn in the stands and other times as assigned
- Scrubs must be worn tied firmly at the waist – scrubs are not a fashion statement; they are a piece of equipment designed to preserve the life of our uniform pants
- Scrub pant legs may be rolled up to prevent dragging on the ground as needed
- Hair must be worn tucked securely to fit under the uniform hat when in uniform
- No makeup
- No jewelry – rings, earrings, watches
- No fingernail polish
- Only clear liquids may be consumed when in uniform
- No condiments on any food items (ketchup, mustard, etc)
- No pizza, nachos or chocolate – drink or candy

FAILURE TO FOLLOW THESE RULES MAY RESULT IN FINES AND COULD RESULT IN THE LOSS OF UNIFORM PRIVILEGES
